

RESOLUTION 15-64

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF WEST SACRAMENTO
ADOPTING THE RESOLUTION 15-64 TO AUTHORIZE STAFF TO PURSUE
THE ADOPTION OF THE CLARKSBURG BRANCH LINE TRAIL, SYCAMORE
TRAIL, AND RIVER WALK TRAIL INTO THE GREAT CALIFORNIA DELTA
TRAIL**

WHEREAS, The Delta Protection Act of 1992 (Act) established the Delta Protection Commission, a State entity formed to plan for and guide the conservation and enhancement of the natural resources of the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta, while sustaining agriculture and meeting increased recreational demand; and

WHEREAS, In 2006, the passage of Senate Bill 1556 (Torlakson) required the Delta Protection Commission to establish a continuous recreation corridor, including bicycle and hiking trails, around the Delta; and

WHEREAS, The continuous regional recreation corridor is to be called the "Great California Delta Trail" and is planned to link the San Francisco Bay Trail system to the planned Sacramento River trails in Yolo and Sacramento Counties; thus creating an extensive trail network estimated to cover more than 1,000 miles; and

WHEREAS, The Delta Protection Commission has requested to designate the existing segments of the Clarksburg Branch Line Trail, the Riverwalk Trail, and the Sycamore Trail as part of the Great California Delta Trail; and

WHEREAS, Once designated as part of the Great California Delta Trail, the Delta Protection Commission will fabricate and install identification signage.


